Chance Foundation is a Canadian registered charity (817519069 RR0001) dedicated to improving the well-being of underprivileged kids in Ottawa and abroad. We envision a world where all kids have access to basic necessities and health services, the opportunity to attend school, and the Chance to play and be a kid. Since our inception in 2007, we have raised more than $\$ 250,000$, completed four major projects, and positively impacted the lives of thousands of kids across four countries.

## Emmanuel Orphanage - Haiti:

In partnership with Jeremie's Children, Amigas (Ottawa), and Fraternité Haïti des TroisLacs, Chance Foundation has been contributing to the relocation and construction of the Emmanuel Orphanage in Jeremie, Haiti. The Emmanuel Orphanage, which supports 52 children, had been operating under deplorable living conditions since 1993.

In January 2011 the Emmanuel Orphanage secured 5,000 square meters of land to build a new home for their kids. Chance Foundation was approached and, with the help of our partners, construction on the new orphanage began. To date, a total of 4 buildings have been built on the new property. Thanks to support from our sponsor and donors, Chance Foundation was able to provide the Emmanuel Orphanage with:

- running, potable water via a complete plumbing system consisting of two 600 gallon cisterns, two 500 gallon cisterns, and one 400 gallon cistern
- a system to collect rain water
- a location identified through a geological assessment to drill a well
- an electrical system on the property, including an inverter, batteries and solar panels
- three complete washrooms with sinks, toilets and showers and an additional 3 toilet/shower stalls
- an outdoor kitchen with new cookware
- a play area for the kids, including a swing set and soccer balls
- an improved food supply in the form of a garden with Moringa trees
- ceramic flooring throughout the main building

Our work with the Emmanuel Orphanage will continue in 2015. In the fall of 2015, based on the results of the geological assessment, Chance Foundation will commission the digging of a well and the installation of a pump to further improve access to potable water.

## Bingham Park - Ottawa

In partnership with the City of Ottawa, Lowertown Community Association, and Desjardins Caisse Populaire Rideau Vision d'Ottawa, Chance Foundation jointly funded the revitalization of Bingham Park in Lowertown, Ottawa.

To ensure proper drainage, the play area was excavated and 36 cubic yards of playground wood fiber safety material was added. The park held a grand re-opening in June 2014 with the following added features:

- a Meteor Net Climber play structure;
- 7 new benches;
- 2 picnic tables fitted with chess boards;
- line games;
- a new waste receptacle and;
- a beautiful community garden.


## Chance Kids Camps:

Chance partnered with the Eastern Ottawa Resource Center (EORC) in order to fund several summer programs for youth at risk in Trappers Park. The Chance camps are important youth initiatives aimed at increasing access to recreational activities and engaging youth in efforts that promoteempowerment and personal safety and awareness. During the 2014 summer camp, children were provided with their own tennis equipment and lessons by qualified instructors. Additionally, Chance Foundation will fund a Young Women on Wellness group for females ages 16-21. This group provides young women with support and information on healthy relationships, self-esteem, budgeting and mental health. This is an 8-10 week program where the young women come together for discussion and activity about the above mentioned topics.
